

For not answering an alarm fishing at the Creeke  
 in Saint Georges hundred commonly called the Hooring  
 Creeke with a seine or other unlawful net and the  
 Offender shall forfeit his net or seine to the private  
 Complainer thereof. Provided that if any Of-  
 fender be questioned for any of these Offences in the  
 Admiralty Court or County Court or before a Justice of  
 Peace that then such Offender shall not otherwise be  
 questioned or punished for the same then in such Court  
 which first questions the Offenders this act to conti-  
 nue till the end of the next General Assembly.

Be it enacted by the Lord Proprietary of  
 this Province of and with the advice and approbation  
 of the Freemen of the same that the Lord of every man-  
 nor within this Province after any manner shall be  
 Erected shall yearly at the first Court Baron held after  
 Michaelmas in every year nominate and appoint some  
 Inhabitant of the manor (not being of the Council  
 to be sitting man of that manor who shall execute  
 all Precepts and warrants to him directed and shall  
 in all things have the like power within the said  
 Mannors as a tithing man hath or ought to have in  
 any Manor in England by the Law or Custom of  
 England and if the person so nominated and appoint-
