

Deputy he shall forfeit two hundred weight of  
 Tobacco to the Lord of the manor and the Com-  
 mander of every hundred otherwise if there be no com-  
 mander the Lieutenant General of the Province for the  
 time being shall yearly at the first hundred Court in  
 every hundred held after Michaelmas in any year  
 nominate and appoint some inhabitant of the town  
 or post town of the hundred to be high Constable of  
 that hundred who shall execute all process and writs  
 as to him directed and shall in all things have  
 the like Power and Authority within the said hundred  
 as a high Constable of any hundred in England hath  
 or ought to have within his hundred by the Law or  
 Custom of England if the person so nominated  
 shall refuse to serve in the said Office by himself or  
 his Deputy he shall forfeit and lose to the said Pro-  
 vidence five hundred weight of Tobacco and yearly  
 at the first County Court held after Michaelmas the  
 Chief Judge of the said Court shall nominate and  
 appoint one Inhabitant of the County not being  
 of the Council to be Sheriff and Coronier of the County  
 who shall execute or cause or oversee the Execution of  
 all writs and warrants to him directed and shall  
 in all things have the like Power and Authority &  
 shall be answerable with the same duties and Off-  
 fice within the County as a Sheriff or Coronier of any  
 shire in England usually hath or ought to have  
 or is or may be charged with by the Law or the  
 Custom of England & if any Person so
