And the said Sheriff shall choose one of his  
servants and in case he have no servant to accept thereof  
of the Lieutenant General and Council shall appoint  
some person for the Execution of all Corporal Correction  
shame or other punishment to be inflicted on the Body  
or Person of any one and if the person so chosen and  
appointed by the Lieutenant General and Council shall  
refuse to execute the said Office the Lieutenant General  
upon Complaint thereof made unto him shall or may  
condemne the person so refusing by Corporal shame or  
Correction as he shall think fit

And the said Constable and tithing man  
so to be appointed as aforesaid shall take an oath be-  
fore the Commander of the hundred or otherwise before  
the chief Judge of the County Court and the said Sher-  
iff and Coroner shall likewise take an oath before  
the Judge faithfully and diligently to execute the said  
Offices of tithing man constable or Sheriff & Coroner  
and to make true return of all Process writs and  
Warrants to them directed for the year next follow-  
ing this act to continue till the end of the next General  
Assembly
