

# Act for Fees

Be it enacted by the Lords Proprietory  
of this Province of and with the advice and appro-  
bation of the same that these and no more fees  
shall be paid to any publick Judge or Officer

To the Secretary of the Province  
& to his Clerk or the Register of the hundred  
County of Kent for a Return of Warrant three score  
Pound of Tobacco for a Return of a Freehold from  
the Lord of the Province thirty pound of Tobacco  
for any Commiſſion or License extraordinary twenty  
four pound of Tobacco for registering the names of  
Adventurers or their Servants one pound of Tobacco  
of Name for administering the oath of Allegiance one  
pound of Tobacco of head to be paid by the Party him-  
self or otherwise by his or her Parent and Master  
for a paper five Pound of Tobacco for the Probate  
of a Will where the Testators Inventory is not suffi-  
cient to discharge all debts and Legacies if the Inven-  
tory be under one thousand weight of Tobacco five  
pound of Tobacco if above one thousand weight &  
under five thousand ten pound of Tobacco if above  
five thousand weight twenty pound of Tobacco and  
no higher where there is any remainder upon the  
Secretary account all debts and Legacies defrayed  
the Executor shall pay for Probate of the will five
