In Act for the Descent of Land.

Be it enacted by the Senate & Assembly of this Province by and with the advice and approbation of the Freeman of the same that a widow immediately after the death of her husband if she were no Tenant shall be admitted to have during her life to over-lease full of all the Land whereof her husband was seized any time during his continuall except in cases where she hath left undelivered a fine or Termat with her last instrument of severance and she shall remaine in the chief house of her husband during her widowhood and where any person dieth seized of any Land the Guardian of the heir appointed upon the will of the heir be within the age of eighteen years of age enter upon the Land and shall be accountable for the reasonable Profitts thereof to the heir when he cometh of Age and when any person dieth seized of any Land without leaving thereof by will the next heir of such Person to whom the Land ought to descend by the most General Custom or Common Law of England shall or may enter upon all the Land whereof his Ancestor died seized and if such next heir be not living or residing within the Province the nearest heir living within the Province and claiming the same may enter upon the Land and hold it without wait or impeachment until such next heir or nearer heir
