An Act for recovering of
Debts.

Be it enacted By the said Proprietary
of this Province by and with the advice and approbation
of the Freemen of the same that the Complainant
in any action of debt upon Book or account shall
or may sue his Book or account at the first County
Court or the hundred Court of Kent in October or at any
time hereafter.

And the Complainant in any action of debt after
his action entered in the Book of the Register of the said
County or hundred Court and after such Caution given
for Prosecuting of the cause and performing the sen-
tence of the Court to be therein given as shall be reason-
ably desired of him shall or may have a Precept
under the hand of the Register of the hundred Court
of Kent or otherwise a writ out of the Chancery di-
rected to the defendant containing the whole tenor
and Effect of the Plaintiffs Bill and commanding
the said defendant to underwrite his answer to the said
Bill and to bring or send it so underwritten into the
said County or hundred Court or to deliver it to the
Plaintiff or to come to enter his answer in the Regis-
ters Books within a reasonable time limited or other-
wise to be at the next County or hundred Court within
the certain time and place to make answer to the said
Bill and to bring with him his witnesses accounts
