

and all ornaments necessary for his defence upon pain of having Judgment passed against him at the said Court in punishment of his Contumacie and further prohibiting the said Defendant to pay away sell give discharge or any way dispose of his Tobacco or Cattle corn Servants debts or other goods or chattels remaining at that time in his right and Property within the County or otherwise within the hundred of Kent until upon trial of the Cause or satisfying the Complainant or securing the Complainant or securing the Register for the satisfying of the said Bill or the Judgment to be Given therein such Attachment be superseded or released by a writt from the Register or by a discharge of the Plaintiff.

And if the defendant being lawfully served with the said Precept or writt or any other by his Procurement or with his privity and consent shall afterward pay away sell give discharge or any way dispose of any his Tobacco or other goods or chattels being or remaining at the time of the writt served in his right and Property before such release or discharge obtained from the Court or Complainant as aforesaid such disposures shall be void in Law except only it shall be good against the Party or Parties to whom and to whose use they were so unlawfully disposed of and consenting to such unlawful disposure of them and the Tobacco and other goods so unlawfully disposed of shall be delivered in execution.
