

to the Party recovering by Judgment of Law any such unlawful disposition notwithstanding

And another precept or writ of Attachment as the former may likewise be taken out of the Chancery or hundred Court of Rent directed to all or any the debtors of the defendant named upon the writ commanding them and every of them to detain in their hands all such tobaccos or other Goods as are by them due owing to the defendant naming the said defendant and the debt or debts demanded or alledged by the Plaintiff until Leave or discharge of ~~the~~ from the Court or the Plaintiff as afore upon pain of paying all such damages to the Plaintiff as the Plaintiff shall Incure through such parties unlawful Payment or disposition of the said debts after the writ served upon him and the Debtor or debtors served with the said writ shall within a time limited upon the writ underwrite their Answer to the said demand or allegation of the Plaintiff or bring or send it into the Court or enter it in the Registers Book or deliver it to the Plaintiff and if such Debtor or debtors do upon his or their answer deny the debt or debts alledged by the Plaintiff to be in his or their hands due to the defendant he or they so denying shall be put to their oath in Court how much owing to the Defendant by him or them

And Tobaccos and all other Goods and chattels shall be judged to be and remain in the right property and dominion of the owner or planter possessed
