

Upon Cattle or any other Goods or Chattels or upon the Body
 or Person of any one the Sheriff or other Officer to whom the
 writ is directed shall cause the said Corn cattle or other Goods
 or Chattels to be sold at an Auction or otherwise appraised
 or valued upon oath in Tobacco if the Recovery be in To-
 bacco or otherwise in Corn Beaver rattle money sterling
 or otherwise according as the Recovery is by two Justices
 of the County or three or more indifferently chosen by the Sher-
 iff or other Officer to whom the writ is directed and all
 or so much of the said Goods as (at the rates appraised) shall
 satisfy the sum recovered he shall forthwith deliver in
 execution to the party or Parties recovering and the Over-
 plus shall redreague to the Owner

And where there is not sufficient distress of Goods
 the party himself or any his Servants attached shall
 be either sold at an auction or otherwise his service valued
 and Appraised by the month as before and delivered in
 execution to the Party or Parties recovering according to
 the several Proportions of their Recoveries to be his or their
 Servants so long as until the Execution be satisfied accor-
 ding to the rate of the parties or servants Labour apprai-
 sed as before and the Greater Creditor recovering shall
 have first execution upon the Body of such Party or
 Servant attached and so the rest in Order according to
 the Value of the Debt recovered

Provided that any defendant served with
 a writ of Execution or Attachment as afore and not ha-
 ving sufficient Tobacco to pay and satisfy all Creditors
 Recovering shall or may tender any Corn of English
 Planting instead of the Tobaccos to be levied by the
