

of the Freeman of the same that these Offences follow  
 in this Act shall be adjudged offences of treason within  
 this Province to compass or conspire the death of his  
 Majesty the King of England or the Queen his wife or  
 his Son and heir or to levy war against his Majesty or  
 to counterfeit the Kings Great or Privy Seal or his coin  
 or to joyne or adhere to any foreign Prince or State being  
 a professed and declared enemy of his Majesty in  
 any Practice or attempt against his said Majesty

Or to compass conspire and cause the death  
 of the Lord Proprietary within this Province or his  
 Lieutenant General for the time being in the absence of  
 the Lord Proprietary or to levy war against the Lord  
 Proprietary or his Lieut General for the time being in  
 absence of the Lord Proprietary or to joyne adhere or con-  
 federate with the Indians of these parts or any foreign  
 Prince or Governor to the invading of this Province  
 or disturbing the Lord Proprietary of his Signory  
 and Dominion there and all Offences of treason  
 shall be punished by drawing hanging and quarter-  
 any a man by drawing and burning of a woman  
 and the offenders blood shall be corrupted and the of-  
 fender shall forfeit to the Lord Proprietary all his or  
 her lands tenements goods franchises and all that may  
 be forfeited provided that punishment of death shall  
 be inflicted on a Lord of a manor by beheading this  
 Act to continue in force till the end of the next General  
 Assembly
