

Conjunction Provided that in offences which are pe-
 ul treason the punishment of death shall be inflic-
 ted by drawing and hanging of a man by burning
 of a woman and that in the offences of sorcery and
 Blasphemy and Idolatry the punishment of
 death shall be inflicted by burning and the accessories
 to any of these Felonies afore the Felony committed
 shall be punished as the principals this act to endure
 till the end of the next General Assembly

An Act allowing, Book to Certain Felonies

Be it enacted by the Lord Proprietary
 of this Province by and with the advice and appro-
 bation of the same that these offences following
 in this act shall be adjudged Felony within this
 Province Man slaughter malicious trespasses as to
 burn or destroy wilfully a house or stack of Corn or
 tobacco or to cut out another tongue and the like
 mischiefs done to another out of pure malice forgery
 which is the wilful emberrling or corrupting of a Record
 mere Contempt with force as to assault or beat the
 Lieutenant General of the Province for the time being
 or to assault or beat any Judge sitting in Court or wit-
 nesses or Juror in presence of the Court accessories to
 Felony after the Felony committed which is the re-
 ceiving hiding or rescuing of a Felon knowing him
 to be one except it be the Felons wife or the receiving
 of Stolen Goods knowing them to be stolen Steath
 of ones self which is the unlawful departure of a
