

shall thereby purchase such Party or Parties so deficient  
 in such pair as the defect shall deserve in his discretion  
 so it exceed not thirty pound of Tobacco for one default  
 and all arrears <sup>to</sup> imposed shall be paid to the Ser-  
 jeant or Marshall to his or their own use

And the said Captain or Commander shall forth  
 with furnish or supply the party or parties deficient  
 with all such necessary arms and ammunition as are  
 afore appointed and shall impose any price upon  
 the same not extending to above double the value  
 of the said arms and ammunition according to the  
 rate then usual in the Country

And upon any alarm every Freeholder of eve-  
 ry hundred having in his family three men able to  
 bear arms shall send one man completely armed for  
 every such three men and two men for every Five  
 and so proportionably to such place as shall be appoin-  
 ted or notified by the Commander or high Constable  
 or other Officer of the hundred and the householders  
 within Saint Marks hundred shall send their men  
 as afore to the Chappell yard near the Fort except any  
 other place be appointed by the Lieutenant General  
 or the Captain for the time being and every householders  
 delaying to send such man or men according to the  
 Order aforesaid for longer time than the man or men  
 might have been conveniently sent shall be fined  
 in the Petitionall Court according to the nature of the  
 Offence or Contempt this act to Continue till the end  
 of the next General Assembly
