© In Act for fencing of Ground

Every man shall fence his Corn and other ground
against Cattel at his own perill and the owner of
Inure may not be Compelled to tan his sowne this
act to endure for two years after the end of this
Assembly

An Act prohibiting the exportation of Corn

No Person shall export any Corn or meal
except for ship provision or that it be in exchange
for a like quantity of Corn imported unless the rate
of Corn be estimated and sold at 30 Tobacco [&] Barrell
upon forfeiture of the said Corn exported or attempt-
ed to be exported out of the Province to the contrary
hereof or a fine to the value of it Corn shall be ac-
cepted at any time in payment at 30 Tobacco [&] Bar-
rell. This act to endure for two years after the end of
this Assembly

© In Act for the Planting of Corn

Every hand planting Tobacco shall plant and
tend two acres of Corn upon pain of forfeiting 200
Tobacco for every acre where default shall be and
so likewise for less default this act to endure for
