An Act touching Marriages

No Party may solemnize marriage with any no-
man before the Banns 3 days before published in
some chappell or other place of the Country where pub-
lick instruments are used to be notified or else afore
Cithrault and licentia ventral in the County Court that
within Party is apprentice or ward or precontracted
or within the forbidden degrees of consanguinity or
cousin Government of Parents or tutors and certificate
of such outward caution taken from the Judge or
Register of the Court upon pain of fine and recompence
to the Party Guined this act to endure for 2 years af-
ter the end of this Assembly

An Act touching Servants Clothes

A Servant at the end of his service shall have by
the Custom of the Country one good Cloth suite of Kersie
or Broad Cloth a shift of white Linnen one new pair
of Stockings and shoes two hoes one axe 3 Barrels of
Corn and 50 Acres of Land five whereof at least to
be plantable women servants a years Provision of Corn
and a like Proportion of Clothes and Land

An Act for raising Artificers wages

The County Court may moderate the bills wages
and rates of artificers Labourers & Chirurgens accor-
ding to the most current rate of Tobacco proportioned
to the rate of the price of the same or the like art
