The Oath of a Viewer

You shall swear to view without delay with such
 Ordinary diligence as you use or would use in Tobacco
 to be received by you self all Tobacco whereof your
 Judgment shall be demanded within the hundred of N
 by virtue of the Law in that Behalf made you shall
 not permit a purchase or contract to or with any person
 or persons directly or indirectly to be wilfully or wittingly
 connivent partial or difficult in the allowing or dis-
 allowing of any Tobacco by you to be viewed nor shall
 you at any time after such viewing directly
 or indirectly take or receive any Gratuity hire recom-
 pence or benefit in one thing or other for or in consi-
 deration of such viewing allowing or disallowing
 of any tobacco more or further than the lawful fee but
 true and impartial judgment shall make and give
 whether it be bad or no by the intent of the said Law ac-
 cording to the best of your skill and Conscience and if
 you find it bad you shall like true Judgment make
 whether you think it bad for the Greater part or no &
 if you judge it bad for the lesser part only you shall
 cutt all the bad out of it as neerly and exactly as you
 may with ordinary diligence and the same shall burn
 according to the Law and if you judge it bad for the
 Greater part of it you shall burn or cause the whole
