Whereas at the last Session of Assembly the
house was prorogued until the next Monday after
twelfth day now for certain reasons I have thought
fit to prorogue it further until the first Monday in
March next whereof I require all persons whom it
may concern to take notice

The Assembly prorogued again till the
first Monday after twelfth day next

16th July 1641

The Prorogation anticipated by Proclama^{tion}
and appointed to be held on 2 August next

Warrant to Commander of Kent to assemble
the freemen at the request of any Burges^s desiring it
