August 2<sup>d</sup> By Lieutenant General  
 The house adjourned till Monday follow<sup>ing</sup>  
 but anon after the said adjournment was altered till  
 Only Thursday next.

28<sup>th</sup> July 1641

Whereas I was appointed by warrant from  
 the Governor to return the names of our Kentish Burgef-  
 ses to you these are therefore to certify that the Inhabitants  
 have thought good only to appoint Captain Brent &  
 M<sup>r</sup> Udarns not desiring any more least the charge of  
 this be equal with the former.
