

security to pay the Value of the Legacy or such part
of it as the debts shall require if the rest of the Estate
be not solvent to Creditors that then that Party
shall have his Legacy in kind

And in all Cases concerning rights demand-
ed from by or out of those estates which the Sicut
General shall administer the Council of the King
shall be understood Judge and because according
to this and some other Laws some cases may arise
where the assistance of the Council will be necessary
& the present Council may either dye or be absent
or be disagreeing equally therefore it shall be lawful
in any Cases aforesaid for the Sicut General to nomi-
nate one or more Councilors to the Effects aforesaid

And in all Cases of administration the ad-
ministrators shall for his care and pains taken therein
have ten in the hundred of the value of that part of
Estate sold at an auction and after the same rate shall
have in kind of such part of the estate as shall be reserved
in kind and moreover and above such ten in
the hundred he shall be allowed out of the estate all
such Charges as he shall make appear to have been
paid out for the behoofe of the estate this Law to revoke
any former law concerning causes testamentary &
to endure for two years unto the end of the next Sessi-
ons before two years
