Bills Enacted for Laws at the Session of General Assembly 23 of March 1641

An Act for the putting in Force of some Laws for the Government of the Prov<sup>t</sup>

Whereas at the General Assembly held the 19<sup>th</sup> day of March 1638 there was an act made ordain<sup>g</sup> certain Laws for the Government of the Province which Act being now expired is necessary to be revived at least in divers places of it until other Laws be devised in place thereof be it therefore enacted that so much of the said Act as concerneth the rights of the Said Proprietor and the Peoples liberties the power of Judicature in Civil and Criminal Causes the Captain of the military Band Officers Fees the setting the house of Assembly the paym<sup>t</sup> of debts among all Creditors by equal Partition the Clause of Forfeitures left out and the custom of Tobaccos shall be revived & stand in force to all intents and Purposes until the end of the next Assembly which
