

Let the General Assembly
 held at Saint Maryson the 19th day of July
 1642 Enacted by the Lord Proprietary with
 the Consent of the freemen as followeth
 Any ten members of the house at any time
 assembled at the usual or appointed time whereof
 the Lieutenant General and six Burgesses to be
 seven unless sickness do hinder that number in
 which case only the members present to make the
 house; this act to repeal all other or former touching
 the house of Assembly this act to endure till the end
 of the next Assembly

Published under the Great Seal the 20th day of
 July 1642

An Act for Support of the
 Enacted the 30th Government
 July 1642

For the better support of the Lord Proprietary
 all Tobacco's ship'd to be transported out of the Pro-
 vince (except England Ireland or Virginia as the last
 Port) shall pay a Custom of five in the hundred
 to his Lordship

This Act to endure till the end of the next Assembly

An Act for Judges

The Judge in all Causes shall be such Persons
 or Persons as were or shall be from time to time
