

which shall be kept upon a file by the Clerk of the Court for the Justification of his entry and if the Judge find the Jury evidently partial or willful he may charge another Jury to enquire and try by the same Evidence and if they find contrary to the former judgment all the former Jury may be fined at the discretion of the Judge

His act to endure till the end of the next Assembly

An Act providing some Rule for Executions

All Lands Goods and chattels executed upon by the Sheriff (other than Solvaco and necessary cloth Bedding utensils and tools of party in execution) shall be sold at an Auction to such persons as the Sheriff shall answer for or the party interested will accept and in defect of such then they shall be appraised by three men or the greatest part of them whereof one to be chosen by the Sheriff another by the owner and a third by the Creditor and if they all differ that appraisement shall stand which is made by him nominated by the Sheriff for else they shall be appraised by the Creditor or some by him appointed and if the Owner like them at that rate and pay or secure the Creditor for them he may have them at that rate or else may deliver them at that rate to the Creditor

And the party recovering may have an Injunction against any the Debtors of the Party recovered upon to command them to pay such debts to the party
