

of or applied to any other use until such Judgment  
 be released by the Party or Officer or by writ or of  
 higher Court or be satisfied by paying the sum adjudged  
 or tendering it in such manner as the Law allows  
 in that behalf or be balanced by judgment of like or  
 Greater Value against the party upon pain of mespris  
 in all Parties provided the Trespas shall be punish  
 ed by Fine and treble damages and the Corn or Tobacco  
 so disposed of wheresoever found shall be restored to  
 the use of the Judgment and the Party or any them  
 to whose use any Corn or Tobacco stands so bound  
 may at any time upon the neglect or inability of  
 the Owner use defray and perform all care charge  
 and diligence needful to such Corn and Tobacco to bring  
 it in case to be payable and put it to the acct of the  
 Owner and after allowance of it by the Judge shall  
 have such charge added to the Judgment to all the  
 same effects as if it had been comprised in the Judgment  
 at the first.

And if there be more Judgments then one given  
 upon any Corn or Tobacco such Corn or Tobacco  
 afore it be applied and paid to the use of a former  
 Judgment shall stand bound in like manner as  
 afore to the use of every judgment according to the Order  
 of the Judgments except the Party having Precedent  
 Judgment be in delay of executing of it Provided  
 that Landlords Rents judgments for publick Services  
 to the use or account of the Province / allowed by act  
 or house of Assembly and judgments for Customs and
