

by the Lieutenant General Commander of any County calling to him one or two neighbours shall at some time in January yearly view the Store or quantity of Corn then being in every Family within the hundred and estimate the same and inquire and take the names <sup>or</sup> names of every person belonging to every such Family and certify the same upon oath before the first of February yearly unto the Lieut<sup>t</sup> General Commander of the County by him to be certified without delay to the Lieut<sup>t</sup> General

And all Persons exporting or attempting to export before without such license as aforesaid shall forfeit the Corn so exported or attempted to be exported on the pain of it and it shall be judged out of the Store if it be sold or delivered to any Indians

This act to endure till the end of the next Assembly

An Act determining what shall be Judged a Sufficient tender

It shall be judged a sufficient tender of Tobacco in any Debt if he tender it at some place within the County where the Debt doth dwell / except it be otherwise agreed upon the day when it is due or otherwise if after the striking of it at any time before the 16<sup>th</sup> day of March he warn the Creditor or his Attorney in the County to come and receive it and after 20 days after such warning in case the Creditor nor his Atty be in the County to be warned / then after 20 days after such striking in the presence of two or more credible freemen he may make oath of the Soundness
