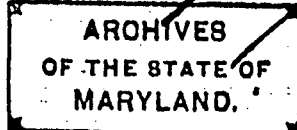


and weight of the Tobacco he weigh and mark the Tobacco to the use of the Creditor after which time it shall remain as the proper Goods of such Creditor and any Party privy other then such Creditor (or some other by his Consent and appointment) using, harming or taking away such tobacco after such tender made shall make fine and pay trebled damages to the party grieved

The table of Officers Fees

Ordered and published by the Sicut General and Council on the first day of August 1642 to be paid in Tobacco with Casks

Fees of the Secretary of the Prov^r or Clerk of any County Court

Item for entering any matter upon record five pound $\frac{1}{2}$ Page Item for entering a deposition or for a Certificate or Copy of a Record ten pound $\frac{1}{2}$ Page Item for drawing and recording a Commission License or certificate in parchment 30 Item for drawing and Recording the patent of a Manor if it be in paper only sixty pound if it be in Parchment one hundred Pounds and into this sum all entries to be returned touching such Patent but if it be but a freehold then half the Fee to be paid as for a Manor Item for Probate of wills or Letters
