

Then the further reading of the Laws was twice
made and the Governor proposed a Bill to be drawn
for the repeal of all the Laws made last Assembly

Then was read the second time the Bill for the
Expedition &c and altered with some amendments

Then the same Committee was appointed to
sit as yesterday, only Mr Wiston's place to be sup-
plied by David Whiddell for the drawing up of
other Branches appertaining to the safety of the
Colony

And the Lieut General adjourned the house till
the third meeting of the day at 4 Clock afternoon
