

Refused to be admitted till the names of the persons were to it whom it pretended to personate

Then it was put to the question for what time the Bills should be made to endure

And that they should endure for three years or else to the next meeting of a Assembly if an Assembly be within that time was voted by the Governor Mr Secretary Mr Surveyor Mr Binks Thomas Hebdens & Mr Weston for themselves and Proxies

That they should endure for three years certain voted by Captain Commanders Mr Brent Mr Greene Nick Hervey Randall Rebell, Jo. Medley Francis Pose and Nicholas Coon for themselves and their Proxies

Then by appointment of the Governor was read the Bill for the expedition and that it should be Engrossed was voted by the Governor Secretary Surveyor Mr Weston Thomas Hebdens Mr Binks and Francis Pose that it should not was voted by the Captain Mr Brent Mr Greene Nicholas Hervey Randall Rebell John Medley and Nicholas Coon for themselves and their Proxies

Then were all the Bills read again and all of them including the bill for the expedition were voted to be engrossed none more contradictory except the Bill for Officers

Which was voted to be engrossed by the Governor Secretary Surveyor Mr Weston Tho Hebdens
