 Helden & Mr Weston & Mr Surveyor and likewise

Then was read the account of John Hallones  
 and Ordered by the house that he should be allowed  
 1000 l. tobacco and Henry Hooper the Drummer 100  
 tobacco and that these sums should be levied 2 shares  
 of it upon Saint Marys County and 1 upon Kent  
 the apportionment of the hundreds in Saint Marys to be  
 by J<sup>r</sup> & Council and in Kent by the Commander &  
 Commissioners the Sheriff to collect it and hereafter  
 the rate of 10<sup>th</sup> of Centum of the sum collected

Then was read the Protest of some of the house  
 against his Lordships Power of Adjournment of  
 Assemblies
