

of them if it be in the Provincial Court or if it be
in the County Court) the Commander and Com-
missioners of the County or the Major part of them
then present in () shall be judges in all Causes
as aforesaid not exceeding their Commission so that
after Judgment there be Power of Appeal to either Par-
ty to the Provincial Court. & Provided that the Sheriff
General of the Province or any one of the Council or
the Commander of the County of Kent (or in his absence)
the next in Commission then being in the County, may
determine and correct any Offences which have or may
be determined and corrected by a Justice of Peace in
England any thing in this act notwithstanding

And if the votes of the Judges be equal that
Judgment shall be entered which is given by the
Chief Judge in Commission

Provided that no Judge may exercise any
Act of Judicature in any cause or matter wherein
himself is interested or a Party nor before he have
taken an oath to administer equal Justice to all Per-
sons according to the Laws of the Province to the
best of his Skill and power and to delay nor deny
to no man right or Justice

And in case of absence out of the County or
hundred of all others at that time in Commission
or in Case of default of all others in Commission
(being in the County or hundred and having lawful
Notice and Warning of the Court) the Chief Judge
in Commission may judge and determine all
