### 3) An Act for Rule of Judicature

Right and just in all Civil Causes shall be de-  
 termined according to the Law or most General  
 Usage of the Province since its Plantation to be  
 determined by the Judge and in default of such  
 Law or Usage then right and just shall be determi-  
 ned according to equity and good Conscience not  
 neglecting so far as the Judge shall be informed  
 thereof and shall find no inconvenience in the ap-  
 plication to this Province) the rules by which right  
 and just use and ought to be determined in Eng-  
 land in the same or the like cases

And all Crimes and Offences shall be judged  
 and determined according to the Law of the Province  
 or in defect of certain Law then according to the  
 best discretion of the Court

Provided that no Person be a Judge of life  
 member or freehold nor be outlawed or exiled or  
 fined to above the Value of one thousand weight of
