10 An Act providing some Rule for Executions.

The necessary Clothing bedding and tools of any Party may not be taken in execution but all other the Lands Goods and Chattels of any Party executed upon by the Officer shall be sold at an Auction to such Person as the Officer will answer for or the Party interested (being present) doth not except against

And in default of such then they shall be appraised by three men one the Greater part of them whereof one to be chosen by the Officer another by the Owner and a third by the Creditor or party recovering or his assignee and if they all differ that appraisement shall stand which is made by him nominated by the Sheriff or Officer

Or else they shall be appraised by the Creditor for some by him appointed and if the Owner like them at that rate and pay or secure the Creditor for them he may have them at that rate or else may deliver them at that rate to the Creditor

And the Party recovering may have an injunction against any the debtors of the Party recovered upon to command them to pay such debts to the Party recovering and to authorize his discharge

And if the debt be not due at that time the Creditor may have an injunction to stop them in the
