

The Lieutenant General and Council if it be in the County of Saint Mary and the Commander and Commissioners of Kent if it be in that County shall have Power to Rectify the Quittance according to equity & the true intent of this Act.

And if any thing be remaining in stock after the expedition finished it shall be returned to the Counties proportionably and from the Counties proportionably to every hundred and from the hundred to particular persons proportionably to their charge.

And all Perquisites and benefits arising growing or acquired from any enemies prosecuted by this expedition by any treaty present or composition for peace or satisfaction for injuries done shall be to the use & Accompt of the Province and upon demand for the Provincial Court of any Freeman in the name & behalf of the Province of any Party or Parties possessed of such perquisites or benefits such Party or Parties so possessed shall be liable to accompt and restitution and the perquisites so acquired shall be distributed proportionably to the Counties and from each County to every hundred and from thence to particular Persons according to the Proportion of their charge to the expedition until the said Charge be fully satisfied and recompenced.

25 An Act providing some things for the better Safety of the Colony

Whensoever the necessary Defence of the Prov^o or any Part thereof against an Assault or invasion of the
