Whereas I have appointed to hold a Generall As-
sembly at S^t Marys on Tuesday the third of December
next these are to summon all freemen inhabiting with-
in this Province to be at the said Assembly at the time
and place aforesaid either by themselves or their Proxies
or Burgesses to consult and advise with me touching
the Affairs of the Province whereof they are not to
fail at their Perills

I do Authorize W^m Secretary in case of my ab-
