Summons to George Sayer to be at the Assembly forthwith upon sight &c<sup>a</sup>

Was read certain Orders to be Observed in the house during the Assembly

Came Mr Marguett Brent and requested to have vote in the house during self and voice also for that at the last Court 3 January it was ordered that the said Mr Brent was to be lookt upon and received as his Lordships Attorney

The Governor denied that the said Mr Brent should have any vote in the house and the said Mr Brent protested against all proceedings in this present Assembly unless he may be present and have vote as aforesaid

Published Cos (Orders &c<sup>a</sup>)

1 That no one of the house shall use any railing speeches or name any one by his name but by another signification viz the Gent that spoke last or the like

2 That no one shall speak above once at one reading to any Bill without License of the Governor and if two Persons rise up together the Governor shall appoint who shall speak first and no one shall interrupt another or speak till the other hath ended

3 That no one shall deliver his opinion or speak
