

every Bill sitting but shall stand up reverently and bare headed directing his speech to the Governor

4<sup>thly</sup> That every Bill proposed to the house shall be read three several days before it shall be engrossed and that between every such reading or reading shall be intervened unless with special license of the Governor

5<sup>thly</sup> That before the General day of Sessions for the making of all the Laws notice shall be given three days before at the least to all the County of Saint Marys to make their personal appearance if they shall like thereof

6<sup>thly</sup> That no one shall come into the house of Assembly (whilst the house is set) with any weapon upon penalty of such fine or censures the house shall think fit

7<sup>thly</sup> Any of the sixteen members bound to attend the Assembly that shall be absent from the house at the hour and place appointed shall be fined (after the number of ten of them shall be present with the Governor and the Clerk) in the sum of 50 of Tobacco unless lawful excuse shall be shewen to be employed in defraying the charges of this present Assembly

8<sup>thly</sup> All misdemeanors which shall happen in the house shall be censured and fined by the house to be employed as afores

9<sup>thly</sup> Any one of the sixteen members that shall not attend the house either through sickness or other urgent Occasion shall have Power to constitute another Proxie in his Room during his absence

The house adjourned by the Governor till to morrow morning
