The house adjourned by the Governor till tomorrow  
9 Clock to their Sessions of the Country

Saturday 29 January

The members all assembled

Nicholas Gryther petitioned to the house for  
his freedom which Mr Fenwick Attorney of Captain  
Cromwells denieth to him

Upon the petition of Nicholas Gryther the house  
considered that they found no service due to Mr Fen-  
wick from the said Nicholas Gryther but that the  
Product of his labour over and above his necessary  
maintenance / after the war was done should be co-  
ming to Mr Fenwick the said Nicholas Gryther to  
bring in upon oath a just account into the house  
between this and Monday morning to the time that  
his service expired

Thomas Oliver petitioned to the house that either  
Mr Fenwick Attorney of Captain Cromwells per-  
form the Contract which the said Thomas made with  
the said Captain Cromwells or else to be at his own  
disposal

Upon the petition aforesaid the said Mr Fenwick  
not being able to perform the Contract according to Condition  
The house ordered that the petitioners should be at  
his own disposal,
