of Mr James that by virtue of his Letter of Ally gave
unto Mr Thomas Thourbough the plantation which
was formerly the said Mills to enjoy forever upon Con-
dition that he would come into the Country and seal
upon it and likewise the several depositions
upon Record how that Mr Cabot late Governour did
Confirm what was formerly belonging to the said Mr
Thourbough in Maryland before his last coming
into the Province to resume the Government and
did give the said Plantation unto the said Mr Thour-
bough so the freemen assembled in this General As-
sembly do generally and unanimously bind our
selves to save the said Mr Thourbough harmless &
to stand betwixt the said Mr Neal and him whereby
he the said Mr Thourbough may go upon the said
Plantation & enjoy the same
