To Francis Jones 1 Barrel at 50..... 50

To Bart. Rench 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> Barrel at 50..... 75

To Bart Philips 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> at 60..... 150

To Monsieur Overt 1 Barrel at 150..... 150

To William Marshall 2 Barrels for one borrowed of him towards my dyett

To Governor Cabret for head Corn to the Fort 2 Bushells

The other <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> Bushell lost and wasted in measure

A True acc<sup>t</sup> of necessaries bought for my livelyhood since
