

betwixt the neighbouring Indians and the Inhabitants
of this Province be it enacted by the Lord Proprietary with
the advice and assent of this Assembly that any who-
ever that shall take enterprize transport or Cause to be
transported out of this Province and sell or dispose of any
Friend Indian or Indians whatsoever or endeavour to
attempt so to do without license from the Governor for the
time being and all Accessories thereto shall suffer death
but not forfeit there or any of their estates howbeit any one
informing or causing such Offendor or Offendors to be appre-
hended shall have satisfaction for his pains and diligence
therein out of the said Offendor's Estate and Goods as the
Governor and Council shall think fit and it is further
Enacted by the Authority aforesaid that no inhabitant of
this Province shall deliver any Gun or Guns or Ammu-
nition or other kind of martial Arms to any Indian born
of Indian Parentage for the killing of man or any other
use without license from the Governor for the time being upon
pain of forfeiture to lose Lord Proprietor one thousand
Pound of Tobacco in cash and loss of the Parties Gun
to him that shall make seizure thereof or take the same
from such Indian or inform or make Proof hereof And
Ousamazmah being now servant to W^m Fennick is hereby
Excused from this Law
