## An Order touching the Lord Proprietors stock of Cattle and other Estate within this Province

Whereas his Lordship is informed that he hath suffe-  
red many and Great Injuries and Losses by the disposall  
of his stock of Cattle and other his Lordships estate  
within this Province which said stock of Cattle with  
other his Lordships estate was engaged by Leonard Cal-  
vert Esq<sup>r</sup> his Lordships late Governor here before his death  
to divers Soldiers here for their pay for their service in the  
Defence and Safety of his Lordships Province and since de-  
livered according to the said late Governors Engagement  
aforesaid notwithstanding which this present Assembly  
being desirous to give his Lordship content satisfaction  
herein it is Ordered by this present Assembly that no In-  
habitant of this Province shall alienate transport or  
cause to be transported out of Saint Marys or Kent Coun-  
ties or shall alter the property of any Cattle or other Estate  
which they are now Possessed of and which belonged  
to his Lordships estate at or since the death of the said  
Leonard Calvert but shall preserve the same with the whole  
Increase in their Custody and Possession until the last  
day of March next or until his Lordships Pleasure be
