## An Act for Punishment of some other Offences

Every Person striking any Officer Juror or Witness in presence of the Court or striking any other Person with a drawn weapon in presence of the Court or striking any Magistrate in or for doing his Office may be judged to lose his or her right hand or be burned in the hand or be put to any other Corporal shame or correction or be fined as the Provincial Court or other Judge thereunto Authorized shall think fit Every person that shall strike a High Sheriff of a County or other Officer in or for executing of his Office shall be fined or censured as the Court and Council present in Court or Commander or Commissioners authorized from time to time for matters of Judicature in any County Court within this Province shall think fit Everyone giving false witness upon oath or perswading or hiring another to give such false witness upon Oath shall be nailed to the Pillory and lose both
