

Under the hand of the Governour and the Great Seal of the Province as fully to all Effects in Law as if they were advised and assented unto by all the freemen of the Province personally

Orders made and agreed upon by the Assembly for the better ordering of both Houses.

1 That no member of either House shall use wringing speeches or name any of the members of either house by his own name but by the term or denomination of the Gentleman that spoke last or the like

2 That none of either House shall speak above once at one reading of any Bill without License of the Governour or Speaker respectively and if two Persons rise up together the Gov^r or Speaker respectively shall appoint who shall speak first and no one shall interrupt another or speak till the other have ended.

3 That none shall deliver his opinion or speak to any Bill sitting but shall stand up Bareheaded directing his speech to the Governour or Speaker respectively

4 That every Bill proposed to the House shall be read three several days before it be voted to Ingrossment unless upon urgent Occasion or in matters of lesser consequence it be otherwise thought fit by both Houses

5 That none shall come into either of the Houses whilst they are set with any Gun or Weapon upon perill of such fine or Censure as the Houses shall think fit

6 Any of the 14 Burgesses bound to attend the Assembly that shall be absent from their house at the hour and Place appointed the Governour and Secretary or any one of the Council being then assembled is censured or adjudged to pay for every such default 50 lbs and Costs unless just Excuse for such Absence be made appear
