

Province shall erect and make a strong and sufficient fence of four foot and a half high about their Corn which they are by the Law of the Country enjoyned to plant and shall keep in Repair the said fence, all Trespasses and Damages that shall be done to such Corn or any other Commodity enclosed in such a fence as aforesaid shall be recoverable in honor them who shall Commit the Trespass upon the View and Judgment of two honest and indifferent men

All & every person or Persons who shall kill hurt or wrong any Cattle Hogs or Horses breaking into his Ground or else where shall make Satisfaction to the Owners of the said Cattle hogs or Horses for such hurt or damage done the said hurt or damage being first Viewed and Judged by two indifferent men and presented to the Court who shall determine the said damage if they who have done the Injury do not otherwise Agree with those that are wronged by that means

15 Concerning Adultery & Fornication

Every Person or Persons within the Province that shall be found or proved by Confession of either Party or sufficient Evidence to have committed Adultery or Fornication shall be punished as the Commissioners authorized thereunto shall adjudge and determine not extending to Life or member

16 An Act Concerning a Register of Births Marriages and Burials

The Names of all that shall be born married or Buried within the Province shall be Exhibited to the Clerk of every Court who shall keep a Just Register thereof who shall be Allowed five Pounds of Tobacco as a Fee due to him for every such Register made & kept
