

shall not be allowed more than fifty Cent Gun and all Offenders herein shall be Adjudged to pay one third part or Value of all such Goods and Servants bought and Sold to the Contrary hereof to the Party informing or Prosecuting and able to make just Proof thereof against such Offenders and the other two parts of all such Goods or Servants or Value as aforesaid shall be forfeited to the publick use,

30 An Act prohibiting Foreigners to trade in the Province

It is Ordered with the Consent and by the Authority of this present General Assembly that no Foreigner either English or Indian shall presume or attempt to hunt in any part of this Province or kill any Venison or other Game upon pain of forfeiting the one half of all such Boats Canoes Guns or Ammunition brought to the Intent of and Venison or other meat so unlawfully killed and shall also be imprisoned during the Pleasure of the Court where they shall be Apprehended the other half shall be allowed to the Party or Parties so taking pains therein that shall Seize or Apprehend such unlawful hunters or other Goods or Ammunition as aforesaid and every Commander or chief Commissioner in the County shall have Power by Virtue hereof to Grant Warrants or License to any Person or Persons desiring the same to raise men or Force Sufficient for the Apprehending all such unlawful Hunters as aforesaid
