

Concerning Publi^ck Charge

It is Ordered Enacted and Declared in the name of his Highness the Lord Protector of England and by the Authority of this present General Assembly that all Publick Charges of this Province shall this present Year be levied upon all persons taxable of Poll and all men Servants that are or shall be brought into this Province for the future of what Age so ever they be shall be taxable of Poll as aforesaid

Concerning Ground Leaves

It is Enacted and declared in the Name of Highness the Lord Protector of England &c &c by the Authority of this present General Assembly that after this present Year or the first of June next ensuing the Publication of this Act that no Ground Leaves or second Crops of Tobacco be made within this Province and whosoever shall be found culpable of the same and shall pack it in any Hhd or any other Cask or by any other ways or means shall be guilty or deceive any thereby shall for every hhd or Cask wherein any Ground leaves or second Crops be found either by themselves or amongst other Tobacco's for a fine shall pay One thousand pounds of Tobacco & Cash for every hhd or Cask so Packed and sufficient Proof made thereof one half of the aforesaid Fine to be payable to any that shall inform and the other half for the publick Use of the County where such Offences are committed
