 afterwards by other actions quite drowned,
 deservedly lost the memory of the former, In
 case Certainly there is no obligation in
 us Justice to reward, but rather to punish
 who should see high a measure in Justice
 them selves afterwards to the same person
 whom they had so well merited before, as to
 tribute to his destruction. For a Notorious
 from a professed friend, is much more to be
 than from an Enemy. And it is less that
 Peopls there may see and be fully satisfied
 we prefer their Welfare before our own
 particular advantage, and that we are
 dissent to any of the proceedings of the
 Assembly there, But such only as necessary
