 you to referre as an offence done unto our selfe,
 wherefore we require you our said Lieutenant
 and the Rest of our Councell there to be very Diligent
 in vnderstanding our honour on all such occasions
 of contemptuous or scandalous words or actions
 against our said Lieutenant there for the tyme be-
 ing as spoken or done against our owne parts
 which hee represents in that Province. In
 wherunto we will and require you our said
 Lieutenant and Councell there (in case
 the said Parke be not duly punished for his said
 high misdemeanour, or be upon his submission
 pardoned for it before the publishing thereof, in
 our said Province) to cause such punishment
 be inflicted on him as his offence deserveth
 on life upon publick acknowledgment of his
 fault in open Court there, hee doth humbly
 and humbly beseech you our said Lieutenant, as
 craves your pardon for the same with good ap-
 pearance of his part that hee will not fall into
 like error hereafter, but remaine true
 with that respect, duty and Obedience to you
 as hee and as others respectfully due on our go-
 vernment there ought to doe, upon which submission
 acknowledgment and assurance we are willing,
 not otherwise, that this first fault of his in that
 should be pardoned in regard hee hath forme-
 well merited of us, and our said Lieut. brother
 deceased, And whereas there hath bene some
 aspersions (as we are informed) lately laid
 by our said Secretary (Thomas Cotton) sent by our
 Walter Lake concerning some words pro-
 ed to be spoken by our said Secretary in relation
 the Roman Catholics there, Wee doe hereby
 declare that we are fully satisfied of the Innocence
 of our said Secretary by his owne oath of Allegiance
 of himselfe in that particular lately sent unto
 and also by the said Letter from our Honorable
 house mentioned, And doe therefore require you
 said Lieutenant and Councell there, (in case
 not already done) to doe our said Secretary right
 against the said Lake according to Justice, and
 by our said Secretarys Representation there in
