

not have goods, or Chattels sufficient and over  
within this Province to be taken to satisfy  
penalty aforesaid, or that the same be not  
speedily satisfied, That then the person  
and persons so offending shall be publickly  
whipped, and shall suffer imprisonment in  
Kaye, or Mainprize, until he, she, or they  
most pœnitently shall satisfy the party offended  
or griev'd by such reprochfull language by  
asking him, or her respectively forgiveness  
publickly, for such his offence before the Ma-  
gistrate or other Justice Officer or Officers  
of the Town or place where such offence  
shall be given. And Be it likewise further  
likewise Enacted by the authority and con-  
sent aforesaid that Every person and person  
within this Province that shall any tyne  
hereafter prophane the Sabbath or Lords  
Day called Sunday by frequent swearing  
drum beating or by any unwillow disorderly con-  
versation, or by working on that day when absolute  
Necessity doth not require it, shall for every  
such first offence forfeit two shillings &  
pence ster, or the vallue thereof. And for  
second offence five shillings sterling, or  
vallue thereof, And for the third offence  
and for every tyne hereafter offence in  
manner aforesaid, ten shillings sterling  
or the vallue thereof. And in Case such  
Offender and Offenders shall not have su-  
ficient goods, or Chattels within this Provin-  
to satisfy any of the aforesaid penalties re-  
spectively hereby imposed for propi-  
-ning the Sabbath or Lords Day, called Sunday  
as aforesaid, Then in every such Case the  
party so offending shall for the first and  
second offence in that kind be imprison'd  
till he or she shall publickly in open  
Court before the Justice Comander Judge or  
Magistrate of that County Town or Precinct  
wherein such offence shall be committed acknow-  
ledge the fault and offence he hath in it
