to the rest of the unpayable benefits we
have receiv'd by your self's Honorable favor over this
Colony.

An Act concerning purchasing land from the Indians.

Whereas Divers persons have heretofore
purchased lands or accepted of lands or
inments in this Province from Indians, and
have made use of, and possess'd the same, without
any lawfull Title or authority deriv'd from the
Lord Proprietary, neglecting also to take out
Grants from his self's Honor his Great Seal, or
the Province for such lands, as have bene, or
are due unto such persons or persons by
virtue of his self's Conditions of Plantation or other
warrant from his self's Honor which proceedings
are not onely very great Obstructions, and
prejudiciall to his self's Honor, Dignity and Rights, but
also of such dangerous consequence, if not
tymely prevented, that they may hereafter
bring a great Confusion in the Government
and publick Peace of this Province. Be it
therefore Enacted by the Lord Proprietary
with the Assent and approbation of the
Upper and lower House of this Assembly
that all Purchas'd, or Acquisitious either
before or after of any lands or Inments within
this Province, which either already have
bene, or which shall hereafter be made
from any Person or Persons whatsoever
not deriving at the same tyme a lawfull
Title therunto by from or under some
Grant from tyme to tyme obtained or to be
obtain'd from his said self's Honor or his self's Heire, Law
and Ex. in or out of this Province under
