That it is not acted, And be it enacted by
authority and consent aforesaid That All
Inhabitants, and Members of this Province
(excepted) shall be absolutely and freely
pardoned, shall be pardoned whatsoever Capitall
or other committed or perpetrated at any tyme
betwixt the said 14th of February 1644 and
the said fifth of August 1646 And for the better
maintaining of Peace and Unity It is also enacted
by the authority and with the consent aforesaid
that all Rebellions, seditions, practices,
attempts tending to the disturbance of
Unity divine, and intended, and naming a
Rebellion or seditioning of others with matter
of plimouth Rebellion, or any other Odious
or Reproachful terms for any matter
thing pardoned by his Honor abolished by virtue
of this Act be utterly forbidden and laid aside, so
pains of imprisonment during pleasure, fine
bannishment, stocks, Pillory, whipping, a
nd or more of these as the Lieutenant or
Governor and Council of this Province for the
being, or the Major parte of them then being
Court present, whereof the said Lieutenant or
Chancellor, or their respective deputies, being a
one of the said Council to be allowed one, i.
to have a casting Vote shall thinke fitt.

5. All Mutinous or Seditious Speeches, or
attempts without force tending to draw
the obedience of the People from the Right
Honorable Facilius non Lord Baron of Baltham
and Lord Proprietary of this Province, or his
Heires, Lords and Proprietaries of the Province
or the Governour of the same under him, or them, for
the tyme being, and proved by two sworn
Witnesses, shall be liable to be punished with
imprisonment during pleasure not exceding
one whole year, fine, bannishment, bearing
of the Tongue, Slitting of the Nose, Cutting of
or both Eares, whipping, branding with a
L
