fit. And Mutinies or Rebellowed speeches,
practices, or Attempts with force, either against
the person of the Lord Proprietary now being or his
heires, Lords and Proprietaries of the Province, or
of his, or their Governour of the Province for the
time being in the, or their absence out of the Province
or against any the Justices, Justices of the Peace or Guards
provided for the safety of them, or any of them perform
or for the publishing, Establishing or advancing
any other Rights or Titles to the Property or Dominion
of the Province than the Right and Title of him the
said Lord Baron of Baltimore, or his heires,
Lords and Proprietaries of the Province, and all
Deceits (after such force, and proved by two suffi-
cient witnesses as aforesaid) to such speech prac-
tise or attempt shall be liable to be punished by loss of
hand, or by the pains of death, and confiscation
of all lands goods and chattels within the Province
bannishment, imprisonment during life, any or
more of these, as the Provinciall Court shall
adjudge, And all Deceits after to such spee-
ch, practise or attempt with force shall be liable
to be punished in such manner, as in that Law
which is provided for mutinous Speeches and Prac-
tises, without force.

An act for punishment of such as shall forge
the Lord Proprietaries, or his heires Lords &
Proprietaries of this Province Great Seal of
this Province &c.

Be it Enacted by the Lord Proprietary of this Pro-
vince, by and with the consent of the House and
lower House of this Assembly (That what person
or persons soever, shall presume to counterfeit the
Great Seal of this Province for the time being, or the
Signe Manuall or Seal of the Lord Propri-
etary of this Province, or his heires Lord and
Proprietors of this Province, and shall within this
Province make use of any such Counterfeited Seal
or Signe Manuall, as if they were the respective he-
ires or Seal or Signe Manuall of the said Lord Proprietary,
his heires, or shall steal away any of the said true
Seals, or without lawfull warrant and authority
received from the Lord Proprietary, or his heires, &c.
